Missouri's 19 nonprofit Community Action Agencies (CAAs) work statewide to help people achieve self sufficiency. CAAs provide localized, direct services to low-income Missourians. Programs from several CAAs include:

- + Energy & Housing: CAAs help alleviate energy and housing burdens through programs like energy efficiency & transitional housing.
- + **Food**: CAAs help feed families through community gardening & summer food programs.
- + **Education**: CAAs equip families through Head Start, employment training & workforce development.
- + **Health**: CAAs offer preventative care, women's health programs, child dental screenings.
- + Family & Economic Security: CAAs provide a variety of programs to promote economic security like life skills training & financial programs.

Missouri Community Action Network (Missouri CAN) is the statewide association of Missouri's 19 nonprofit Community Action Agencies, Allies, and Supporters united to help people and change lives. We:

- + **Strengthen our Network:** We provide training, professional development, and technical assistance to approximately 3,000 Community Action staff statewide.
- + Advocate for Low-Income Missourians: We educate state and federal policy makers about Community Action programs, and we follow state and federal legislation that may impact low-income Missourians.
- + **Promote Poverty Awareness**: We promote Community Action Poverty Simulations, an interactive learning tool, to expose participants to poverty. We also provide poverty data in publications & social media.
