Missouri CAN advocates for Community Action in Missouri and on the federal level; educates the public about poverty through the Poverty Simulation and biennial Poverty Report; and helps members grow through trainings, webinars, and online courses geared to Community Action staff.

How do I join?

Dues are 0.25% if you make up to \$21,000, and 0.33% if you make over that. The average cost is \$5 a month—the price of a good cup of coffee. You can quit at any time.
